Thank you for your interest in volunteering with the University High School Band Program! Your support is truly appreciated and is absolutely necessary to maintaining a quality program for the sake of our students. This year, the following opportunities to help out are available:

Band Camp Chaperone

August 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 18, 20, and 29 | 4 pm – 6 pm

Band Camp Chaperones help to serve dinner and assist the directors as necessary at band camp, summer rehearsals, and the “Rehearse-athon.”

Band Camp Medical Chaperone

August 3 – August 6 | 9 am – 6pm

August 10 – August 13 | 9 am – 9 pm

The Band Camp Medical Chaperone deals with basic first aid (usually heat-related) and references student medical forms to pass out ice packs, Tylenol, etc. Medical background is appreciated but not strictly necessary.

Uniform Fitting

Some time during Band Camp.

All our students need to be fit for uniforms during band camp. The uniform fitting volunteers help to take and record measurements to facilitate this.

Uniform Repair

Throughout the fall season.

Uniform Repair volunteers are needed to perform basic sewing, hemming, and other maintenance of our marching band and color guard uniforms.

Football Game Chaperone

Fridays during the fall season | 5 pm – 11 pm

Chaperone home and away football games, pass out water, lead groups to the restroom, etc.

Concessions

Fridays during the fall season | 5 pm – 11 pm

During all home Varsity and Junior Varsity football games, the University Classic, and other large events at Cougar Stadium, we need parents to help prepare and distribute food at our concession stand.

Equipment Chaperone

Whenever the band travels.

Equipment Chaperones help to load and unload the truck, move props and instruments onto the performance field, etc.

Competition Chaperone

Saturdays during the fall season | All Day

Competitions are all-day events and require chaperones to help monitor students and assist the director in various capacities.

University Classic

October 17 | All Day

The University Classic is an FMBC marching band competition that we host at University. We need volunteers to help check groups in, coordinate parking, transport equipment, assist the judges and directors, sell merchandise, and various other activities.

Winter Guard Chaperone

Saturdays in the spring

The Winter Guard performs at regionals throughout the spring semester and needs chaperones to help monitor students and to help transport the “floor.”

MPA Chaperone

February and March

Our “Music Performance Assessments” are in the spring and we need parents to help monitor students at these concerts.
