The Winter Guard is a component of the University Band. Guard members are expected to conduct themselves accordingly. The Winter Guard, unlike the Marching Band, is *extracurricular*, not co-curricular. Participation in this group is a privilege and must be earned and maintained through a great attitude, hard work, dedication, and the maintenance of strong behavior and academic excellence.

Attendance Policy

Attendance at ALL practices and performances is mandatory. Students who miss rehearsals may be removed from performance at the director's discretion.

For off-campus events where no bus is provided, students must meet at the show site at the designated report time. Once dismissed, students are responsible for their own transportation home. For off-campus events where a bus is provided, students must be on campus for report time and leave campus no later than half an hour (30 minutes) after the end of a scheduled rehearsal or the ensemble's return from an event.

If you must miss a rehearsal or performance, you must notify both the band directors and guard staff by sending an email with the absence date and a valid reason to guard@UHSband.com.

Financial Responsibilities

The University Winter Guard has a large operational budget to pay for experienced instructional staff, equipment, uniforms, props, and travel. Members of the guard must raise a small portion of this to help offset these costs. The total Winter Guard assessment for the 2025-2026 season will be \$400, due on the 15th of each month.

Please note that these assessments will not cover the full cost of the Winter Guard's operation. All guard members may be required to participate in additional fundraising activities, and small purchases of individual equipment (gloves, tights, makeup, etc.) may be necessary. Members who take no steps to fulfill their financial obligations may be removed from performance at the director's discretion.

Transportation

The Winter Guard rehearses at [Union Park Middle School](#). Students are responsible for securing their own transportation from University High School to practice and must be picked up from the rehearsal site.

[Budgeting for a school bus would raise winter guard fees by hundreds of dollars; to avoid this, students will meet at the performance site for all off-campus events. Students will be responsible for arranging their own transportation to and from performances.](#)



Requirements

A GPA of 2.5 is required to remain eligible for participation in the Winter Guard. Individuals whose GPA falls below this will not be invited to participate. If a member's GPA falls below this during the season, a director/parent/student meet must be held as soon as possible.

A week contains 168 hours; in any given week, there are 8-12 hours of Winter Guard rehearsal. It is not acceptable to use Winter Guard as an excuse to fall behind in your academics.

Students are expected to abide by the OCPs Code of Student Conduct at all times, and to generally behave in a mature and dignified manner.

All members are encouraged to be enrolled in a dance class during the school day. Membership in the marching band is required during the fall unless a prior arrangement is made with the band director.

Dismissal from Group

If requirements are not met, a student may be removed from the group at the discretion of the band director and guard director. Winter Guard fees up until the point of dismissal are not refundable, but no further fees would be assessed.
