- Guard (Irma Connelly, Alexsa Shever) The truck will not be available for the upcoming performance. They are in need a good cart as the current cart fell apart. They found a cart for \$750/\$650. They have raised over \$1100. Could they purchase a cart from that fund? They also need a Volunteer with a trailer to help with the Winter Guard performances and All County. Their first competition is January 27. Mr. Brown will post a volunteer list a Volunteer is needed to transport the cart to and from shows. Before purchasing a cart, Mr. Brown will scout out the school to see if he can find the green cart that has gone missing. FYI: U-Haul does not make donations to school.

The Publix performances on 12/17/22 earned \$1,147.35. The cash was deposited in the FOCPS account. This leaves a balance of \$3,380.16, most of which will be used to pay for the winter guard floor. We successfully paid for the judges for the Classics and the three charter buses for FMBC (\$9,000). Mr. Brown is to check drumline deposit against latest fund report.
